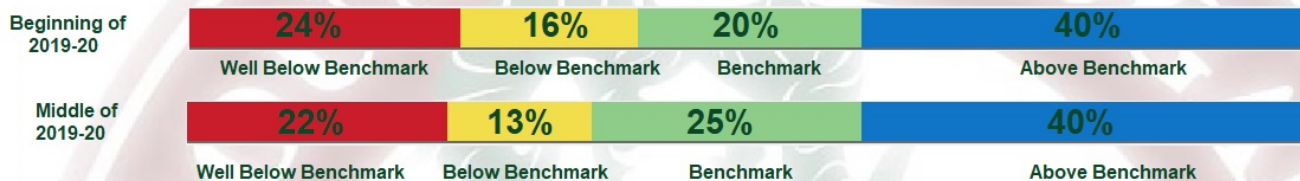


# STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AND DATA

Mt. Mahogany is a proud Title I school, and our focus is always on student improvement and overall well-being. Our Title I, School Improvement, and Trustlands plans all focus on promoting student growth in all areas, with a special focus on literacy. Mt. Mahogany gathers information and feedback from stakeholders by meeting with PTA and SCC several times a year, holding multiple parent nights, administering an online needs assessment, and monthly leadership meetings with school staff.

Our DIBELS scores in K-3 have steadily risen over the last several years. From the beginning of the 2017-18 school year until now, our students in K-3 have shown an average of 9% growth in DIBELS. For the 2019-20 school year, we have adopted DIBELS for K-6 to analyze school-wide data. Here are some important data points from this year:



Grade	# of students who moved from below level to at or above level in DIBELS
Kindergarten	33 students
1st-3rd	58 students
4th-6th	22 students

This information is provided to give you an idea of how our students are improving in DIBELS. Regarding our 2018-19 RISE/SAGE scores, we saw a slight drop, despite our best efforts. As a staff, we do not feel this is an accurate representation of our efforts. However, we reflect frequently on our practice, discuss students results weekly, and consistently develop strategies to improve student learning.
