- **1. Welcome** Mr. Shirley welcomed the Council members for anther meeting and thanked them for their continued service to our school community.
- 2. Celebrations—Mr. Shirley celebrated some recent virtual assembly opportunities, which featured Jason McLeod, star of the movie "Facing the Giants" and a Virtual Stem Night which featured Doug Scheer, a magician and scientist from Michigan. Mr. Shirley also mentioned that the Choose Kindness videos and lessons we have been doing each month have made an impact on our students. Mr. Raddatz celebrated our recent White Ribbon Week which helped our students recognize the importance of staying safe online and with their media choices, and Mrs. Olson echoed how much her students learned from this week. Ms. Atkin talked about how much her students enjoyed our virtual assembly with Jason McLeod.
- **3. Stakeholder Report Review**—Mr. Shirley asked the Council members for feedback on our recent Stakeholder Report and all members liked the format and the information contained in it and would like it to be similar for next year.
- **4. Discussion Items for 2021-22** The Council discussed Title I funding, staffing, enrollment, and grade level needs for the coming school year.
- **5. Trustland Mid-Year Budget Review**—Mr. Shirley let the Council members know that 58% (\$65,000) of our Trustland funds remain for this year and we are on track to spend all these funds. There was also dialogue on how we have 59% (\$284,000) of our Title I funds remaining and how we are also on track to utilize all these funds.

- **6. Upcoming March Cookie Dough Fundraiser**—The Council members discussed the past Cookie Dough fundraisers we have participated in and unanimously agreed that we should keep doing this as it has proven to be successful.
- 7. School Safety/ Covid-19 Update Mr. Shirley let the Council members know that our school is currently in the green and how a majority of our staff have been vaccinated with the first dose. It was also mentioned that during first few weeks of January, a few students were affected by Covid-19, but contracted it from family members. Mr. Shirley let the Council members know that the District is hoping by the end of March that we can start having faculty meetings in person. Mr. Shirley also let the Council know that an influx of PPE came to the school the first week of January which provided us with wipes, adult and child masks, and hand sanitizer.
