2020-2021 Trust Land Goal

Pony Express will see a 3% increase in overall proficiency (composite) from Kindergarten to Sixth grade, from beginning of the year Acadience Literacy Assessment to the end of the year assessment.

2019-2020 Trust Lands Report

Kindergarten to third grade will have a 5% increase in the composite benchmark score of the Acadience Literacy Assessment from the 2018-2019 middle of the year to the 2019-2020 middle of the year.

2018-2019 middle of the year composite score: 75% 2019-2020 middle of the year composite score: 73%

While working through this goal we learned that the comparing measures where not the same and not an accurate measurement of student learning. We have adjusted the goal to compare the same students in the same year.

The percentage of third through sixth grade students reaching proficiency will increase by 2% in all RISE tested subjects by the end of the 2019-2020 school year, compared to the 2018-2019 academic year.

As a result of the 2020 COVID-19 global pandemic RISE testing was canceled and data collection for this goal was not possible.
